Résumé

The Meuse River basin has yielded an important record of Aurignacian occupation, but mostly from 19th and early 20th century excavations. Among those caves excavated at the end of the 19th century, Trou Al'Wesse has been the subject of new works during the last few years. New Aurignacian material has been discovered in a better established context, and which has allowed us to develop more precise ideas about the Aurignacian occupation(s) of this site within a perspective of the Aurignacian record of North-West Europe.
